- All moorings within New London waters require permits. Permit renewal is annually.
- An approved mooring inspector must inspect all moorings at least once every two years.
- New mooring must be authorized by the New London Harbor Master before installation.
- Moorings will be approved if the owner has submitted a copy of the current registration.
