

NOTICE OF RACE THAMES YACHT CLUB OSCAR KERMAN SERIES August 15, 2021

- <u>Rules</u>; Races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the Prescriptions of US Sailing, rules of the PHRF of Eastern Connecticut and the rules of participating one-design classes. Time-on-Time handicapping will be used for PHRF classes.
- <u>2) Eligibility and Entry</u>; The race is open to all racing and cruising handicap boats and to certain one-design classes with a minimum of three (3) entrants. Entries will be accepted and assigned to classes at the discretion of the Race Committee. A current PHRF certificate (whether from ECSA or from the Thames Yacht Club) must accompany the entry form. Boats without an established rating will be assigned one. Entries close at 0930 on the day of the event.
- 3) Fees; \$25 per boat.
- <u>4)</u> <u>Schedule</u>; The series will consist of two races. One in the morning, first warning at 1030, and one after lunch, first warning at 1400. A Skipper's Meeting will be held at the Thames Yacht Club at 0900.
- 5) Starts: The RRS 26 will be employed. Horn at 5...4......1...0 minutes to start. Boats will have their starting signal to cross the starting line. All boats will have their elapsed time calculated from the first time they cross the starting line to the time they cross the finishing line.
- <u>6) Sailing Instructions</u>: Sailing Instructions will be available on the Club's web site (<u>www.thamesyc.org/racing/</u>) no later than August 14th.
- <u>7</u>) <u>Courses</u>; Courses will be determined by the Race Committee, and will be displayed on the race committee vessel "Queen Merry". Marks are as stipulated on the Course Marks and Symbols Chart. Special Marks will be stipulated in the Sailing Instructions. Starting line will be to the east of the "Queen Merry", off the TYC Clubhouse. The finish line shall be the same as the starting line unless the course is shortened.
- 8) Scoring: Corrected times will be combined for overall finish places. Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd for combined results. Race results will be announced at the Clubhouse after the race. Prizes will be awarded at the Thames Yacht Club Skipper's Night.
- 9) <u>Radio Communications</u>; VHF-FM Channel 72 will be used for communication between the race committee and competing boats. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive communications not available to all boats. This restriction applies to mobile telephones and other portable devices.
- <u>10)</u> <u>Prizes</u>; Trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place boats in each class with at least five (5) entrants. Individual race results will be announced at the Clubhouse after the race. Trophies will be awarded at Skippers' Night.
- <u>11) Disclaimer of Liability</u>; Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
