# Thames Yacht Club, New London Youth Sailing Program 2021 Application



Thames Yacht Club is pleased to announce our program for the summer of 2021. Sailing classes are designed for boys and girls between the ages of 6 and 16, regardless of sailing experience. Whether your child is just beginning to sail or is sharpening their skills for a summer full of small boat fun or racing, the staff and facilities of the Thames Yacht Club can enhance any young sailor's abilities. TYC's instructors are certified by the United States Sailing Association and the Club's Junior Sailing Program is associated with the Eastern Connecticut Sailing Association and U S Sailing. The program offers classes to introduce young children to the joy of sailing and start them off with a solid foundation in sailing theory and small boat handling skills. The program also offers classes for more experience junior sailors. On-water instruction is conducted in IOD 95 Optimist Dinghies, and Club 420s. Optimists are sailed /raced by sailors up to age 16. The Club 420s are used for the Optimist graduates and older students and are used in Team Racing events.

## **Program Schedule**

The program runs for nine (9) weeks from June 21 to August 6 and is divided into 1 week sessions. The First session runs from June 21 to June 25.

## Enrollment

- **Registration Form** Complete this form for each sailor and return with your non-refundable \$50 deposit per student, per session, payable to TYC in accordance with the instructions on the bottom of the form. Full tuition payment is due 2 weeks prior to the Session date you select. Class sizes are limited and enrollment will be on a first come basis. NOTE: TYC member priority registration dead line is April 30th.
- **Parents are reminded** All sailors are required to bring a properly fitted US Coast Guard Approved Personal Flotation Device (a.k.a. PFD or Life jacket) with an emergency whistle attached. A swim test is generally given the first day of class.

## **Sailing Classes**

• Opti 1A: For beginner sailors ages 7-9 years old. This class is designed to introduce younger sailors to the Optimist. Knowledge of the boat, rigging, basic sailing, water safety and confidence in handling all points of sail are emphasized.

- **Opti 1B:** For beginner sailors ages 10-15 years old. This class is designed to introduce young sailors to the Optimist or 420 and will move more quickly through the curriculum. Knowledge of the boat rigging, basic sailing, water safety and confidence in handling all points of sail are emphasized. Boat placement based on students size and weight considerations.
- **Opti 2:** For sailors who have successfully completed the Opti1 A or B class. This class will move quickly through the curriculum with a concentration on upwind sailing and will introduce the basic rules-of-the-road and the basics of racing an Optimist.
- **Opti 3:** Learn to Race (LTR): This class is designed for sailors who have successfully completed Opti 2, and desire to improve their sailing skills and/or pursue an interest in racing Optimists. The sailors will learn Sportsmanship and the class will promote more advanced sailing skills with a focus on racing.
- **420:** Learn to Race (LTR)... For sailors who have successfully completed 420 LTS or Opti 3/ LTR. The 420 LTR class is designed for sailors who have knowledge of 420 sailing and who want to learn racing basics. The sailors will learn Sportsmanship and become competitive racing skippers and racing crews. Trapezing and spinnaker sailing will be introduced.
